RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS – SORSOGON FIRST ENGINEERING DISTRICT AND THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT EMERGENCY AND CIVIL SECURITY (TMECS/SK3) TO IMMEDIATELY INSTALL ADEQUATE CCTV CAMERAS AND SPEED LIMIT SIGNAGES ALONG THE COASTAL ROAD CONNECTING ROMPEOLAS AND BARANGAY BALOGO OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, number of road accidents along the coastal road connecting Rompeolas and Barangay Balogo were recorded and one of which led to a loss of human life happened on December 27, 2020;

WHEREAS, CCTV cameras along the coastal road connecting Rompeolas and Barangay Balogo could monitor vehicle movement and could record accidents and crimes;

WHEREAS, installation of speed limit signages therein is equally important to regulate the movement of all vehicles traversing the said road and could prevent further road accidents;

WHEREAS, every year, an estimated 1.2 million die and over 50 million are injured in road accidents across the world, with around 85% of these numbers coming from low- and middle-income countries;

WHEREAS, in 2011, the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr), developed the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011 to 2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road accidents in the Philippines by 50% by 2020;

WHEREAS, in order to reduce, if could not prevented, the number of road accidents along the coastal road connecting Rompeolas and Barangay Balogo, there is a need to install adequate CCTV cameras and speed limit signages therein;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla**, duly seconded by the **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to pass a resolution respectfully requesting the Department of Public Works and Highways – Sorsogon First Engineering District and the Traffic Management Emergency and Civil Security (TMECS/SK3) to immediately install adequate CCTV cameras and speed limit signages along the coastal road connecting Rompeolas and Barangay Balogo of the city of Sorsogon.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.
