RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH)- FIRST ENGINEERING DISTRICT AND THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT EMERGENCY AND CIVIL SECURITY (TMECS/SK3) TO IMMEDIATELY INSTALL ADEQUATE CCTV CAMERAS AND SPEED LIMIT SIGNAGES ALONG THE BOULEVARD, PUBLIC MARKET, OLD MUNICIPAL HALL AND EAST CENTRAL SCHOOL ALL OF BACON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, CCTV cameras along the Boulevard, Public Market, Old Municipal Hall and East Central School all of Bacon District of the City of Sorsogon could monitor vehicle movement and could record accidents and crimes;

WHEREAS, installation of speed limit signages therein is equally important to regulate the movement of all vehicles traversing the said areas and could prevent further road accidents;

WHEREAS, every year, an estimated 1.2 million die and over 50 million are injured in road accidents across the world, with around 85% of these numbers coming from low- and middle-income countries;

WHEREAS, in 2011, the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr), developed the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011 to 2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road accidents in the Philippines by 50% by 2020;

WHEREAS, in order to reduce, if could not prevented, the number of road accidents and pity crimes along the aforesaid areas, there is a need to install adequate CCTV cameras and speed limit signages therein;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Lorenz S. Abenion, duly seconded by Hon. Mary Ellen D. Jamisola, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the Department of Public Works and Highways – Sorsogon First Engineering District and the Traffic Management Emergency and Civil Security (TMECS/SK3) to immediately install adequate CCTV cameras and speed limit signages along the Boulevard, Public Market, Old Municipal Hall and East Central School all of Bacon District of the City of Sorsogon.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.
