RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE 64 BARANGAY SK COUNCILS THE INTEGRATION OF "ADOPT A COLLEGE STUDENT PROGRAM" A POVERTY ALLEVIATION PROGRAM OF THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN AMID COVID 19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the state gives importance to education in adherence to the 1987 Philippine Constitution, under Article II, Section 17, which states: "The state shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerated social progress and promote total liberation and development";

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State that quality education is an inalienable right of all Filipinos, thus, the State shall protect and promote the rights of all students to quality

education at all levels and take appropriate steps to make such quality education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, RA 9155, otherwise known as the Basic Education Act of 2001, declares that, “it is the State’s policy to promote the right of all citizens to quality basic education and make such education accessible to all Filipinos by providing free and compulsory education in the elementary level, and free education in the higher level as well as alternative learning system for out-of-school youths and adult learners”;

WHEREAS, due to Covid 19 pandemic, the members of the Sangguniang Kabataan City Federation unanimously agreed to support the new normal distance learning modalities and shall undertake to prepare and allocate/appropriate the necessary provisions and budgets in their respective barangays in relation thereto;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Kabataan shall integrate as part of their support to uphold quality education in the midst of pandemic shall reserve funds for the integration of a poverty alleviation program through education among the youth;

WHEREAS, the “Adopt a College Student Program” aims to provide necessary provisions, technical and financial support to at least one (1) deserving college students in their respective barangays to help their parents who are within the poverty threshold in sending their children to schools until they graduated;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Ma. Teresa D. Perdigon**, duly seconded by **Hon. Rebecca D. Aquino**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the 64 Barangay SK Councils the integration of “Adopt a College Student Program” a poverty alleviation program of the Sangguniang Kabataan amid Covid 19 Pandemic.
