

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution provides for the right of the people to health and this right necessarily includes the responsibility of each resident to maintain cleanliness in every surrounding;

**WHEREAS**, dog manures carry bacteria that can cause diseases and illnesses and has been found that pet droppings can contribute to diseases of animals that could be passed to humans;

**WHEREAS**, when infected dog poop is deposited in any surface, the eggs of certain roundworms and other parasites can linger in the soil for years and anyone who comes into contact with that soil, be it through gardening, playing sports, walking barefoot or any other means, runs the risk of coming into contact with such eggs and cause sickness to humans;

**WHEREAS**, the parasites that can be brought about by dog feces include Cryptosporidium, Giardia, Salmonella and may also harbor hookworms, ringworms and tapeworms;

**WHEREAS**, sickness that can be brought by dog feces, through said harmful organisms, includes fever, muscle aches, headache, vomiting, and diarrhea to which the children are most susceptible, since they often play in the dirt and put things in their mouths or eyes;

**WHEREAS**, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom; as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitant;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, duly seconded by **Hon. Rebecca D. Aquino**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the Gayon Sorsogon Deputy Administrators for the immediate and regular cleaning or removing of excrement of dogs and other pets in Rompeolas and coastal road located at Barangay Talisay, East District and Bacon Boulevard all of Sorsogon City.
