RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO-SORSOGON), PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP-SORSOGON CITY) AND THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT EMERGENCY AND CIVIL SECURITY (TMECS/SK3) FOR THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF LOCAL AND NATIONAL LAWS ON SPEED LIMIT WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, every year, an estimated 1.2 million die and over 50 million are injured in road crashes across the world, with around 85% of these numbers coming from low- and middle-income countries;

WHEREAS, in 2011, the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr), developed the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011 to 2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road crashes in the Philippines by 50% by 2020;

WHEREAS, since the development of the PRSAP, the number of road crashes has been steadily rising;

WHEREAS, speeding is the most important contributor to road fatalities and is at the core of the road injury problem, as it influences both crash risk and crash severity which significantly affects vulnerable road users;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) prescribes the setting and strong enforcement of speed limits as one of the most effective interventions in reducing road crashes and road crash fatalities and injuries;

WHEREAS, in order to reduce the number of road crashes in the city of Sorsogon and/or minimize their severity, there is a need to regulate and strictly implement all local and national laws on speed limits on roads within its territorial;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, duly seconded by **Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the Land Transportation Office (LTO-Sorsogon), Philippine National Police (PNP-Sorsogon City) and the Traffic Management Emergency and Civil Security (TMECS/SK3) for the strict implementation of local and national laws on speed limit within the territorial jurisdiction of the city of Sorsogon.
