RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OF EVERY BARANGAY IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON FOR THEIR COMMITMENT AND SUPPORT TO THE BASIC EDUCATION CONTEXTUALIZED LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – DIVISION OF SORSOGON AMID COVID 19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the state gives importance to education in adherence to the 1987 Philippine Constitution, under Article II, Section 17, which states: “The state shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerated social progress and promote total liberation and development”;

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State that quality education is an inalienable right of all Filipinos, thus, the State shall protect and promote the rights of all students to quality education at all levels and take appropriate steps to make such quality education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, RA 9155, otherwise known as the Basic Education Act of 2001, declares that, “it is the State’s policy to promote the right of all citizens to quality basic education and make such education accessible to all Filipinos by providing free and compulsory education in the elementary level, and free education in the high level as well as alternative learning system for out-of-school youths and adult learners”;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education has formulated its Public Health Emergency Program, incorporated therein is the Basic education Learning Continuity Plan for School Year 2020-2021 which mandates the preparation of the learning needs of school children in the opening classes through blended learning, distance learning (modular, on-line and TV-Radio based instruction) or homeschooling modalities;

WHEREAS, the city government of Sorsogon had previously approved a resolution and ordinance that pledges its resolute support and commitment to the “Contextualized Learning Continuity Plans” of the Department of Education – Division of Sorsogon;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Kabataan of their respective barangays are actively involved in helping the school and teachers in the distribution of modules to resident pupils and students, donating monetary and other forms of assistance which in a way provide hope among our youth and children to continue their education in the midst of the pandemic and under the new normal learning strategies;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Lorenz S. Abenion**, duly seconded by the **Fernando David H. Duran, III**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to pass a resolution commending the Sangguniang Kabataan of every barangay in the city of Sorsogon for their commitment and support to the basic education contextualized learning continuity plan for school year 2020-2021 of the Department of Education – Division of Sorsogon amid Covid 19 Pandemic.
