**RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) – SORSOGON FIRST ENGINEERING DISTRICT TO REPLENISH OR REINSTALL ROAD AND TRAFFIC SIGNAGES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON**

**WHEREAS**, for the past three (3) months, the Bicol Region was hit by successive typhoons causing a considerable destructions on private and public infrastructures/structures;

**WHEREAS**, among badly destroyed, damaged and ruined are the road and traffic signs stalled in the national highways and local road network of the Local Government Units;

**WHEREAS**, it was observed that after the successive typhoons hit the city of Sorsogon, there are substantial numbers of road and traffic signages previously installed in West, East and Bacon District are reportedly damaged if not missing;

**WHEREAS**, replenishment, replacement or reinstallation of road and traffic signages is necessary to avoid future and imminent danger to lives and properties of our constituents;

**WHEREAS**, every year, an estimated 1.2 million die and over 50 million are injured in road accidents across the world, with around 85% of these numbers coming from low- and middle-income countries;

**WHEREAS**, in 2011, the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr), developed the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011 to 2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road accidents in the Philippines by 50% by 2020;

**WHEREAS**, in order to reduce the number of road accidents in the city of Sorsogon and/or minimize their severity, there is a need to install sufficient warnings on roads by installing appropriate road and traffic signages within its territorial jurisdiction;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of **Hon. Fernando David H. Duran, III**, duly seconded by **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, resolved as it is hereby resolve respectfully request the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) – Sorsogon First Engineering District to replenish or reinstall road and traffic signages within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.


