RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE CITY AGRICULTURIST, CITY VETERINARY OFFICE AND THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE TO STRICTLY ENFORCE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 22, SERIES OF 2020 DATED FEBRUARY 5, 2020 IN RELATION TO NATIONAL ZONING AND MOVEMENT PLAN FOR AFRICAN SWINE FEVER.

Whereas, on September 01, 2020, Dr. Ronnie D. Domingo, DVM, MSc, Director, Bureau of Animal Industry, Department of Agriculture, Diliman, Quezon City issued a memorandum regarding the update on zoning status of regions in relation to the Implementation of the National Zoning and Movement Plan for African Swine Fever (ASF);

**Whereas,** as therein appearing, the Province of Sorsogon specifically Sorsogon City is categorized as Protected Area as far the issue on African Swine Fever is concerned;

**Whereas, as** also appearing thereof, nearby Province of Camarines Sur have municipalities categorized as infected zones, thus there is a need to guard and tighten our borders and institute plans in order to ensure that African Swine Fever will not enter our locality;

**Whereas**, the City A**gr**iculturist, City Veterinarian and Philippine National Police plays a vital role in the enforcement of the aforementioned Administrative Order No. 22, series of 2020 dated February 05, 2020;

Whereas, foregoing premise considered and after due deliberation on the matter, the 7<sup>th</sup> City Council deemed it necessary to pass a resolution enjoining the City Agriculturist, City Veterinary Office and the Philippine National Police to strictly enforce Administrative Order No. 22, series of 2020 dated February 5, 2020 in relation to National Zoning and Movement Plan for African Swine Fever;

Now therefore, on incidental motion of City Councilor Nestor J. Baldon duly seconded by City Councilor Ralph Walter R. Lubiano, resolve as it is hereby resolved to enjoin the City Agriculturist, City Veterinary Office and the Philippine National Police to strictly enforce Administrative Order No. 22, series of 2020 dated February 5, 2020 in relation to National Zoning and Movement Plan for African Swine Fever;
