RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE CREATING ADDITIONAL PLANTILLA POSITIONS UNDER THE OFFICE OF CITY MAYOR, CITY HEALTH OFFICE, CITY TOURISM, CULTURE AND ARTS OFFICE AND THE CITY TREASURY OFFICE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF FOR THE PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Local Government Units (LGUs) play major role in a community's development, provide links between people and government, address its community's problems and concerns, enforce policies and hold influence over its communities;

WHEREAS, the need to identify the workforce that can most efficiently deliver these services to the public is necessary to augment to the present number of employees in the Local Government Unit of Sorsogon;

WHEREAS, under RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod, subject to the provisions of the same and pertinent laws, has also the power/authority to determine the powers and duties of officials and employees of the city. (RA 7160, Sec. 458(1) (vii);

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from; as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment and culture, promote health and safety, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Ralph Walter R. Lubiano, duly seconded by Hon. Rebecca D. Aquino, resolve as it is hereby resolved to enact an ordinance creating additional plantilla positions under the Office of the City Mayor, City Health Office, City Tourism, Culture and Arts Office and the City Treasury Office and appropriating funds thereof for the purpose.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING ADDITIONAL PLANTILLA POSITIONS UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, CITY HEALTH OFFICE, CITY TOURISM, CULTURE AND ARTS OFFICE AND THE CITY TREASURY OFFICE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF FOR THE PURPOSE

Be it ordained by the 7th Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1:

TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as the "Ordinance for the Creation of Additional Plantilla Positions in the City of Sorsogon".

SECTION 2:

SCOPE/COVERAGE

This ordinance shall cover the creation of additional plantilla positions of the herein offices, and all other related provisions necessary and appropriate therefor.

SECTION 3:

CREATION OF ADDITIONAL PLANTILLA POSITION

It is hereby created the additional plantilla positions of the following offices with the following qualification standards, to wit:

SECTION 4:

APPROPRIATIONS

The City Government shall appropriate the corresponding funds annually and provide necessary funding requisites for the salary and other monetary benefits and incentives of additional plantilla positions as herein created that are allowed under the existing laws and administrative issuances relative thereto.

SECTION 5:

REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations, or any part(s) thereof which are inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6: SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any person or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provision hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVITY

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Sangguniang Panlungsod and after compliance with the law on public dissemination and of publication.
