RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE 64 BARANGAY SK COUNCILS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INFORMATION DRIVE CAMPAIGN IN THEIR RESPECTIVE BARANGAYS FOR COVID 19 MASS VACCINATION PROGRAM OF THE GOVERNMENT IN LINE WITH THE POLICIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND THE NATIONAL TASK FORCE FOR COVID 19

WHEREAS, vaccines mimic the virus or bacteria that causes disease and triggers the body's creation of antibodies, thus, the antibodies will provide protection once a person is infected with the actual disease-causing virus or bacteria;

WHEREAS, amid the looming possibility of an uptick in cases of COVID-19, as well as the threat of the new variant, the government has already ramp up the plans and preparations for the vaccine procurement and inoculation;

WHEREAS, with the BIDA steps and observance of minimum public health standards, vaccination is an important way to protect everyone from getting severe COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the government is continuing negotiations to ensure adequate vaccine supply for all Filipinos, including those not in the priority groups;
WHEREAS, the public shall be more vigilant with the information found online and continue observing the minimum public health standards to prevent further transmission of the virus;

WHEREAS, the 64 Barangay SK Councils of the city of Sorsogon are hereby enjoined to help the government in its massive information drive campaign in their respective barangays for Covid 19 mass vaccination program of the government in line with the policies of the Department of Health and the National Task Force for Covid 19;
