RESOLUTION ADOPTING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 42, SERIES OF 2021 – AN ORDER ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR BOTH GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENTS/EMPLOYERS FOR THE CONTINUOUS IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CURRENT MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS AND IN THE RAMPING UP OF VACCINATION AGAINST COVID – 19 IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, the Hon. City Mayor Ma. Ester E. Hamor, on December 31, 2021 has issued Executive Order No. 42, Series of 2021 -An order establishing additional guidelines for both government and private establishments/employers for the continuous implementation of the current minimum public health standards and in the ramping up of vaccination against Covid – 19 in the city of Sorsogon;

WHEREAS, EO 42-2021 of the Local Chief Executive is in response to AITF-EID Resolution No. 148-B, Series of 2021, dated November 11, 2021 enjoining all government agencies to implement measures prioritizing fully vaccinated individuals availing of government programs and services;

WHEREAS, every establishment/organization be it government or private has the obligation of providing protection to their personnel especially their frontline workers to allow them to continue providing their services to their clients;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of EO 42-2021 provides that:

“ALL ESTABLISHMENTS AND EMPLOYERS, both government and private shall require their personnel who are tasked to do on-site works to be vaccinated against Covid- 19 for their own protection as well as their clients.”

“Eligible personnel who opted not to be vaccinated shall be required to undergo RT-PCR testing regularly at their own expenses for purposes of on-site work. In case of personnel who are not yet fully-vaccinated (only got 1st dose of the 2-dose primary vaccination), they shall not be assigned as frontline workers or be detailed to field works until they are declared as fully vaccinated”

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla** duly seconded by Hon. Fernando David H. Duran, III, resolved as it is hereby resolve to adopt Executive Order No. 42, Series of 2021 -An order establishing additional guidelines for both government and private establishments/employers for the continuous implementation of the current minimum public health standards and in the ramping up of vaccination against Covid – 19 in the city of Sorsogon.
