RESOLUTION EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT TO SENATE BILL NO. 2124 AND HOUSE BILL NO. 10698 PROVIDING HONORARIUM FOR SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN AND INSTITUTIONALIZING ADDITIONAL REFORMS TO REVITALIZE YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNANCE

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 2124 and House Bill No. 10698, both bills seek to amend portions of Republic Act No. 10742 or the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Reform Act of 2015;

WHEREAS, the Senate and the House of Representatives approved on third and final reading the measure to grant monthly pay or honoraria to Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) members to help “revitalize youth participation in governance” and appropriate certificates of civil service eligibility;

WHEREAS, during their respective sessions, the Senate and House of Representatives ratified the bicameral conference committee report on the two bills

which seek to amend Republic Act No. 10742 or the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Reform Act of 2015;

WHEREAS, the reform also expands the functions of SKs to include skills training, youth empowerment, environmental protection, values education, human rights and gender equality and other programs specific to the vulnerabilities affecting young people which SK programs should promote;

WHEREAS, the measure also states that all SK officials, during their incumbency, will receive honoraria, allowances, and other emoluments as may be authorized by law or by an ordinance;

WHEREAS, as part of amendments to Republic Act 10742, the measure also mandates every SK within 60 days of assumption into office, to appoint SK Secretary and Treasurer, wherein SK Treasurer, shall have an education and career background related to either business administration, accountancy, finance, economics or bookkeeping;

WHEREAS, foregoing premises considered and after due deliberation on the matter, the 7th City Council deemed it necessary to pass a resolution expressing full support to Senate Bill No. 2124 and House Bill No. 10698, providing honorarium for Sangguniang Kabataan and institutionalizing additional reforms to revitalize youth participation in local governance;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Lorenz S. Abenion** duly seconded by **Hon. Erwin J. Duana**, resolve as it is hereby resolved to express full support to Senate Bill No. 2124 and House Bill No. 10698, providing honorarium for Sangguniang Kabataan and institutionalizing additional reforms to revitalize youth participation in local governance.
