**RESOLUTION URGING ALL UNVACCINATED SENIOR CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITH COMORBIDITIES IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON TO BE VACCINATED AS AID TO THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SORSOGON TO FULLY ATTAIN HERD IMMUNITY, TO QUALIFY AND BE CLASSIFIED UNDER ALERT LEVEL 1 AND TO HELP THE GOVERNMENT IN ITS ECONOMIC RECOVERY EFFORTS**

**WHEREAS**, vaccines mimic the virus or bacteria that causes disease and triggers the body's creation of antibodies, thus, the antibodies will provide protection once a person is infected with the actual disease-causing virus or bacteria;

**WHEREAS**, amid the possible recurrence of looming uptick cases of COVID-19, as well as the threat of another new variants, the government has already ramp up the vaccine procurement and inoculation, to which senior citizens and persons with comorbidities are among the priority sectors thereat;

**WHEREAS**, with the BIDA steps and observance of minimum public health standards, vaccination is an important way to protect everyone from getting severe COVID-19, thus all senior citizens and persons with comorbidities in the City of Sorsogon are encouraged to get vaccinated;

**WHEREAS**, all local government units and the national government are in its effort to attain local and national herd immunity to qualify and be declared or classified under Alert Level 1, in support to its efforts for economic recovery;

**WHEREAS**, there are still senior citizens and persons with comorbidities in the City of Sorsogon, who are undecided, with fear or misinformed about the benefits of being fully vaccinated;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of **Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla**, duly seconded by **Hon. Lorenz S. Abenion**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to urge all unvaccinated Senior Citizens and Persons With Comorbidities in the City of Sorsogon to be vaccinated as aid to the City Government of Sorsogon to fully attain herd immunity, to qualify and be classified under Alert Level 1 and to help the Government in its economic recovery efforts.
