RESOLUTION EXTENDING INDEFINITELY THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DRY RUN OF NUMBER CODING 1 AND 2 TO TRICYCLE FOR HIRE OPERATING IN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON.

WHEREAS, following the recent declaration of National Inter Agency Task Force on COVID 19 placing the Province of Sorsogon under Alert Level Two, the Sangguniang Panlungsod endeavored to immediately address the plight of the Tricycle Transport Sector in the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon;

WHEREAS, as part of the consultative process, the Committee on Transportation conducted series of committee hearing wherein Tricycle Transport associations were invited

wherein tricycle transport associations were asked to decide what particular coding shall be adopted given the presence scenario;

WHEREAS, as reflected in the Committee Report rendered by the Committee on transportation duly adopted by the 7th City Council in session assembled, tricycle transport associations unanimously voted to adopt the Number Coding Scheme given the present scenario;

WHEREAS, relative thereto, the Chairman of the Committee on Transportation agreed to endorse the unanimous decision of the Tricycle Transport Associationsa subject to the following conditions to wit;

1. Only two (2) passengers shall be allowed inside the side car and one (1) additional passenger behind the driver (back rider);
2. The use of Plastic barriers shall be voluntary;
3. Wearing of face masks by the driver and passengers shall be strictly observed at all times;

WHEREAS, foregoing premises considered and after due deliberation on the matter, the 7th City Council deemed it necessary to pass a resolution extending indefinitely the implementation of Dry Run of Number Coding 1 and 2 to Tricycle for Hire operating in the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon;

NOW THEREFORE, on incidental motion of **City Councilor Franco Eric O. Ravanilla**, duly seconded by **City Councilor Ma. Teresa D. Perdigon**, resolve as it is hereby resolved to extend indefinitely the implementation of Dry Run of Number Coding 1 and 2 to Tricycle for Hire operating in the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all tricycle transport associations and other concerned for their information and guidance.
