RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE MANAGEMENT OF SORECO II THROUGH ITS GENERAL MANAGER ENGR. ERWIN JOSEF R. TABUENA TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR METERED CONNECTION OF STREET LIGHTS FACILITIES IN THE BARANGAYS OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, SORECO II has set the deadline for metered connection of street lights facilities of the barangays on March 31, 2022 after which non-metered connection will be cut off;

WHEREAS, some barangays failed to implement metering last year due to the absence of funding which would entail a considerable delay;

WHEREAS, the corresponding budget for the purpose has been duly provided for in the 2022 annual budget but the implementation of metered connection was delayed considering the fact that program of work has to be prepared, PhilGEPS posting to facilitate public bidding has to be undertaken and the election ban;

WHEREAS, an extension for the implementation of metered connection is necessary, otherwise, the barangay will suffer the darkness to the detriment on the safety of the public;

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom; as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, duly seconded by **Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the management of SORECO II through its General Manager Engr. Erwin Josef R. Tabuena to extend the deadline for metered connection of street lights facilities in the barangays of the City of Sorsogon.
