**RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE CITY TREASURER'S OFFICE TO CONDUCT
INSPECTION AND CALIBRATION OF ALL GASOLINE STATIONS
OPERATING IN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF
SORSOGON**

WHEREAS, Liquid Petroleum Products are considered indispensable commodity
by the community;

WHEREAS, these commodities are vital in order for our transport industry, private
individual motorcycle and car owners and other gasoline dependent endeavours to
pursue continuous operations and partake with their distinct roles in our society;

WHEREAS, the unpredictable gasoline price in the world market with the present
escalating trend influence aforementioned sector of our society wherein parties tends to
be disappointed;

WHEREAS, in order to protect the interest of our gasoline, diesel and kerosene consumers, monitoring, conduct of gasoline calibration is indispensable especially during minimal decrease in gasoline prices in order to ensure compliance of gasoline stations;

WHEREAS, records from the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod reveals that an ordinance was passed and approved by the 4th City Council under City Ordinance No. 2, series of 2013 dated February 12, 2013 entitled **“AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING CALIBRATION AND SEALING OF DISPENSING PUMPS OF RETAIL OUTLETS SELLING LIQUID PETROLEUM PRODUCTS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF SORSOGON CITY, IMPOSING FEES IN THE REGISTRATION AND SEALING OF DISPENSING PUMPS, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”**;

WHEREAS, foregoing premise considered and after due deliberation on the matter, the 7th City Council deemed it necessary to pass a resolution enjoining the City Treasurer’s Office to conduct inspection and calibration of all gasoline stations operating in the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **City Councilor Franco Eric O. Ravanilla** duly seconded by **City Councilor Danilo A. Deladia**, resolve as it is hereby resolved to enjoining the City Treasurer’s Office to conduct inspection and calibration of all gasoline stations operating in the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon;
