## Resolution No. 356, Series of 2021

RESOLUTION ADOPTING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 29-2021 OF GOVERNOR FRANCIS JOSEPH G. ESCUDERO AND THEREBY REQUESTING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON TO PROVIDE SPECIAL PRIVILEGE DISCOUNTS ON THEIR GOODS AND/OR SERVICES AND SPECIAL LANE FOR FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS IN SUPPORT TO THE GOVERNMENT'S EFFORTS TO RAMP UP VACCINATION ACTIVITIES IN ALL LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS

**WHEREAS,** vaccines mimic the virus or bacteria that causes disease and triggers the body's creation of antibodies, thus, the antibodies will provide protection once a person is infected with the actual disease-causing virus or bacteria;

**WHEREAS,** amid the looming uptick in cases of COVID-19, as well as the threat of the new variants, the government has already ramp up its mass vaccination program for the inoculation of its citizens to attain herd immunity;

**WHEREAS,** with the BIDA steps and observance of minimum public health standards, vaccination is an important way to protect everyone from getting severe COVID-19 and prevent transmission to others, thus all qualified individuals aged 12 years old and above should be encouraged to get vaccinated;

**WHEREAS,** Executive Order No. 29-2021 of Governor Francis Joseph G. Escudero was issued on November 8, 2021 -ordering the City and Municipal Mayors in the province of Sorsogon to ramp-up vaccination activities, providing incentives thereof and for other purposes;

**WHEREAS,** Section 2 of Executive Order No. 29-2021 provides target vaccination per LGU by which the city of Sorsogon is directed to ensure that the vaccination program meet the 15, 232 weekly target for six (6) weeks as prescribed by the Provincial Health office;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the Executive Order incentivized vaccination activities wherein LGUs were enjoined to implement incentive programs to further encourage individuals to be vaccinated, such as to encourage establishments in their territorial jurisdiction to provide discounts or special lanes for vaccinated individuals;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Lorenz S. Abenion, duly seconded by Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla, resolve as it is hereby resolved to adopt Executive Order No. 29-2021 of Governor Francis Joseph G. Escudero and thereby requesting all business establishments in the city of Sorsogon to provide special privilege discounts on their goods and/or services and special lane for fully vaccinated individuals in support to the government's efforts to ramp up vaccination activities in all Local Government Units.
