**RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY APPEALING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH)
TO CONSIDER PENDING RENEWAL OF LICENSES OF TRAINED PERSONNEL FOR BASIC
LIFE SUPPORT (BLS) AS COMPLIANCE IN SUPPORT TO THE APPLICATION FOR
LICENSE TO OPERATE A TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITY**

WHEREAS, Basic Life Support (BLS) Training provides basic knowledge, skills and
attitude to perform with confidence basic life support techniques to save lives;

WHEREAS, the city government of Sorsogon through its City Health Office applied
for License to Operate quarantine facilities before the Department of Health (DOH) and
thereby in the efforts to complete prescribed requirements such as but not limited to
trained personnel for Basic Life Support (BLS);

WHEREAS, due to Covid 19 Pandemic, BLS trained personnel of the city
government failed to renew their licenses and thereby causing delay in the submission of

complete requirements for the application for License to Operate quarantine facilities (Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility);

WHEREAS, absence of the License to Operate quarantine facilities, the city government cannot apply for accreditation before the Philhealth, hence, Philhealth members in the quarantine facilities could not avail the Covid 19 benefit package under the system;

WHEREAS, the city government of Sorsogon is appealing to the Department of Health (DOH) to relax their policy on the compliance of the requirements for the application for License to Operate quarantine facilities and to consider the pending renewal of licenses of trained personnel for Basic Life Support (BLS) as already compliance thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, on incidental motion of **Hon. Franco Eric O. Ravanilla** duly seconded by **Hon. Erwin J. Duana**, resolve as it is hereby resolved to respectfully appeal to the Department of Health (DOH) to consider pending renewal of licenses of trained personnel for Basic Life Support (BLS) as compliance in support to the application for License to Operate a Quarantine Facility (Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility).
