**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY AGRICULTURE'S OFFICE TO REVISIT  
THE PROVISIONS OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 14, SERIES OF 2005 ENTITLED  
"FISH SANCTUARY ORDINANCE OF SORSOGON CITY" AND THE SAME IS  
RESPECTFULLY REQUESTED TO BE IMPLEMENTED AND BE ALLOTTED  
WITH CORRESPONDING BUDGET FOR THE PURPOSE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Sorsogon adheres to the provisions of Local Government Code to the protection and conservation of natural resources and the promotion of ecological balance and as well as each development on the aspect of food security;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Sorsogon has identified areas and portion of Sorsogon City waters as fish sanctuaries and the same needs to be implemented thus concerned office must take cognizance on its importance considering the scarcity of fish resources;

**WHEREAS**, it is hereby requested that the City Agriculture Office must have provisions on establishing fish sanctuary in Sorsogon City as one of their primary programs to be able to have sustainable resources;

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed necessary that City Ordinance No. 14, Series of 2005 “Fish Sanctuary Ordinance of Sorsogon City” be deemed appropriated to be able not to defeat its purpose;

**WHEREAS**, implementation of said ordinance and expanding it would further promote the regeneration, conservation and sustainable management/productivity of fishery and aquatic resources; achieve food security for its growing population and sustained, steady supply of fishery and aquatic products;

**WHEREAS**, foregoing premises considered and after deliberation on the matter, the 7<sup>th</sup> City Council deemed it necessary to pass a resolution respectfully directing the City Agriculture’s Office of the City Government of Sorsogon to revisit City Ordinance No. 14, Series of 2005 entitled “Fish Sanctuary Ordinance of Sorsogon City” and the same is respectfully requested to be implemented and be allotted with corresponding budget for the purpose;
