**RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CITY HEALTH OFFICE AND VOLUNTEER
VACCINATORS' FOR MAKING THE CITY OF SORSOGON RANKED 2 IN THE
BICOL REGION FOR THE MOST NUMBER OF VACCINE INOCULATED
DURING THE NATIONAL BAYANIHAN BAKUNAHAN OF THE DOH AND
INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF EMERGING
INFECTIOUS DISEASES (IATF-EID) HELD ON NOVEMBER 29 TO DECEMBER
1, 2021**

WHEREAS, vaccines mimic the virus or bacteria that causes disease and triggers the body's creation of antibodies, thus, the antibodies will provide protection once a person is infected with the actual disease-causing virus or bacteria;

WHEREAS, in a bid to further accelerate the vaccination roll-out, the national government has conducted an aggressive initiative that intends to protect an additional 15 million Filipinos by the beginning of December;

WHEREAS, considering the threat of the omicron variant, the government has also ramp up the plans and preparations for the vaccine inoculation and thereby conducted a 3-day National Bayanihan Bakunahan held on November 29, 30 and December 1, 2021, employing a whole-of-society approach by mobilizing all concerned national government agencies, all the local government units, the medical community, religious organizations and the private sector, to participate in this massive endeavor;

WHEREAS, despite falling short of its target vaccinations on the said activity, the same was considered a success;

WHEREAS, the City of Sorsogon has inoculated 4,923 individuals during the National Bayanihan Bakunahan and held as rank 2 in the Bicol Region;


