**RESOLUTION URGING THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) OFFICIALS TO HELP WIDEN INFORMATION DISSEMINATION AND INITIATE ACTIVITIES THAT WILL STRONGLY MOTIVATE QUALIFIED YOUTH ESPECIALLY FIRST TIME VOTER TO REGISTER FOR THE COMING SK AND BARANGAY ELECTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 13 of the Philippine Constitution provides that "the State recognizes the vital role of children and youth in nation building and shall promote their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being and inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;"

**WHEREAS**, the youth plays a vital role in the improvement of the current condition our society, including leadership and are expected to advance innovations, technology, education, politics and peace of the country;

**WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 1 of the Philippine Constitution further provides that "SUFFRAGE may be exercised by all citizens of the Philippine not otherwise disqualified by law, who are at least 18 years of age and who shall have resided in the Philippines for at least one year, and in the place wherein they propose to vote for at least six months immediately preceding the election:"

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Elections reports that there is 65.7 million registered voters of which 56% or 37,015,901 belong to the age bracket 18 to 41 years old;

**WHEREAS**, it is important that we encourage the youth to register so the they can exercise to right to suffrage as an important civic duty and participation in nation building;

**WHEREAS**, that Sangguniang Kabataan officials have access to various activities and platforms that will help inform, educate and encourage the youth to take an active role in the state of affairs of our government including determining the leaders of our country such as conducting forums, house to house voter's IEC and maximizing the use of social media platforms for the voter's information campaign;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of **Hon. Renalene Mae J. Duka**, duly seconded by **Hon. Danilo A. Deladia**, resolve as in it hereby resolved to urge the Sangguniang Kabataan officials to help widen information dissemination and initiate activities that will strongly motivate qualified youth especially first time voters to register for the coming SK and barangay elections.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.
