RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE PNP-SORSOGON CITY, CITY-ENRO AND THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT EMERGENCY AND CIVIL SECURITY (TMECS/SK3) TO EFFECTIVELY IMPLEMENT CITY ORDINANCE NO. 05, SERIES OF 2021 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PET FECES DISPOSAL ORDINANCE OF 2021 WITH SPECIAL ATTENTION AT ROMPEOLAS AND COASTAL ROAD LOCATED AT BARANGAY TALISAY, EAST DISTRICT AND AT BACON BOULEVARD TO MAINTAIN THEIR TOURISM VALUE AND SANITARY CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, it was observed that there are numbers of pet owners allows their pet dogs to poop elsewhere within in the premises of Bacon Boulevard, Rompeolas and stretch of the coastal road affecting their tourism value/assets and sanitary conditions;

WHEREAS, dog feces/excrement could seriously post health hazard to the customers of the food establishments in the area, tourists, visitors and to the general public that runs counter against constitutional provision for the right of the people to health and this right necessarily includes the responsibility of each residents to maintain cleanliness in every surroundings;

WHEREAS, dog manures carry bacteria that can cause diseases and illnesses and has been found that pet droppings can contribute to diseases of animals that could pass to humans and the city government shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, the 7th City Council, on February 2, 2021, has passed and approved City Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2021, otherwise known as the “Pet Feces Disposal Ordinance of 2021”;

WHEREAS, the ordinance mandates the immediate cleaning or removing of feces of dogs and other pets in public places in the City of Sorsogon or to any private property not owned by the owner or person in charge of the dog or pet and imposing penalties in violation thereof;

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the ordinance provides that any party, aggrieved or not, may file a complaint before the Barangay where the place of the violation was committed, to the PNP-Sorsogon City, City-ENRO or to Traffic Management Emergency and Civil Security (TMECS) which have the authority to issue a citation ticket for the purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Mark Jayson D. Jamisola**, duly seconded by **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the PNP-Sorsogon City, City-ENRO and the Traffic Management Emergency and Civil Security (TMECS/SK3) to effectively implement City Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2021 otherwise known as the “Pet Feces Disposal Ordinance of 2021 with special attention at Rompeolas and Coastal Road located at Barangay Talisay, East District and at Bacon Boulevard to maintain their tourism value and sanitary conditions.
