RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE CITY ENGINEERING OFFICE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS- 1ST ENGINEERING DISTRICT TO MONITOR AND STRICTLY ENFORCE THE MANDATORY INSTALLATION OF WARNING SIGNS AND DEVICES VISIBLE DURING DAYTIME AND AT NIGHTTIME IN ALL ROAD CONSTRUCTIONS AND REPAIRS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, road and traffic control and warning devices provides primary means of communicating important information to street and highway users and provides regulatory, warning, and guidance information to the general public for their safety and general welfare;

WHEREAS, road control devices must be visible to be effective, thus, there are numerous methods that can be used to provide daytime and nighttime visibility of traffic control devices;

WHEREAS, every year, an estimated 1.2 million die and over 50 million are injured in road accidents across the world, with around 85% of these numbers coming from low- and middle-income countries;

WHEREAS, in 2011, the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr), developed the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011 to 2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road accidents in the Philippines by 50% by 2020;

WHEREAS, in order to avoid road accidents in the city of Sorsogon and/or minimize their severity, there is a need to monitor and strictly enforce the mandatory installation of warning signs and devices visible during daytime and nighttime in all road constructions and repairs, hence, this request;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, duly seconded by **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to enjoin the City Engineering Office and the Department of Public Works and Highways- 1st Engineering District to monitor and strictly enforce the mandatory installation of warning signs and devices visible during daytime and night time in all road constructions and repairs in the City of Sorsogon.
