RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS – SORSOGON FIRST ENGINEERING DISTRICT TO INSTALL RUMBLE STRIPS ALONG THE INTERSECTIONS AND ALL ACCIDENT PRONE AREAS AT THE COASTAL ROAD CONNECTING BARANGAY PANGPANG, WEST DISTRICT AND BARANGAY BALOGO, EAST DISTRICT ALL OF SORSOGON CITY

WHEREAS, the coastal road connecting Barangay Pangpang of West District, to Rompeolas and Barangay Balogo of East District was established to cater more accessible roads for the public;

WHEREAS, it was observed and many of the motorists traversing the intersection at the Rompeolas and those going to either Barangay Pangpang or to Barangay Balogo caught in surprise while driving along the area that may cause traffic accidents, due to lack of road safety measures such as the rumble strips;

WHEREAS, installation of rumble strips and other road safety features in the said area are necessary to avoid future and imminent danger to lives and properties of our constituents;

WHEREAS, every year, an estimated 1.2 million die and over 50 million are injured in road accidents across the world, with around 85% of these numbers coming from low- and middle-income countries;

WHEREAS, in 2011, the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr), developed the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011 to 2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road accidents in the Philippines by 50% by 2020;

WHEREAS, in order to avoid road accidents in the city of Sorsogon and/or minimize their severity, there is a need to install sufficient road safety measures on roads such as installing rumble strips to alert inattentive drivers of potential danger, by causing a tactile vibration and audible rumbling transmitted through the wheels into the vehicle interior;

WHEREAS, rumble strips is applied along the direction of travel following an edge line or centerline, to alert drivers when they drift from their lane and may also be installed in a series across the direction of travel, to warn drivers of a stop or slow down ahead, or of an approaching danger spot;


NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Maria Theresa S. Gonzalez**, duly seconded by **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the Department of Public Works and Highways – Sorsogon First Engineering District to install rumble strips along the intersections and all accident prone areas at the coastal road connecting Barangay Pangpang, West District and Barangay Balogo, East District all of Sorsogon City.
