RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MANAGEMENT OF PETER PAUL PHILIPPINES CORPORATION TO PROVIDE THE CITY COUNCIL WITH AN UPDATE/STATUS OF THEIR FAITHFUL COMPLIANCE WITH EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS PARTICULARLY ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS

WHEREAS, during the past years there had been several complaints from the residents in the periphery of the Peter Paul Philippines Corporation specifically from the fisherman and fishpond owners of fish-kill due to the alleged disposal of water pollutants in nearby streams and tributaries;

WHEREAS, there were also complaints from the constituents in adjacent barangay particularly within the East District of Sorsogon City regarding the pungent odor of the smoke emitted from the chimney stacks of PPPC which is a familiar sight everyday and in all probability can be considered as a contributory factor in air pollution.

WHEREAS, there had been several occasions that the Management of the Corporation, the Engineers and their Legal Counsel acceded to the invitation and thereby appeared during the regular session for purposes of clarifying the complaints and related issues lodged against the company in the presence representatives from CENRO and DENR;

WHEREAS, the officers from the Peter Paul Philippines Corporation during the deliberations as regards the complaints partly admitted that they are in the process of adopting remedial measures and assured some of the members of the august body of their willingness to fully cooperate in this regard and their readiness for the conduct of inspection.

WHEREAS, considering the afore-stated premises it is timely and proper that Peter Paul Philippines Corporation be requested to provide the city council with an update and status of their compliance with existing laws, rules and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Bryan J. Pingul duly seconded by Hon. Nestor J. Baldon, resolved as it is hereby resolve to request the management of Peter Paul Philippines Corporation to provide the city council with an update/status of their faithful compliance with existing laws, rules and regulations particularly environmental laws.
