**RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE CITY PNP TO INTENSIFY POLICE VISIBILITY SPECIALLY IN ALL SCHOOL CAMPUSES AND CONDUCT PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES TO ENSURE SAFETY OF PUPILS, STUDENTS AND SCHOOL PERSONEL IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON.**

**WHEREAS**, netizens of social media have been sharing posts about kidnapping incidents in some part of the Philippines and the posts claimed that victims of kidnapping are mostly pupils in the elementary schools and/or students in secondary and tertiary level;

**WHEREAS**, although these claims were still subject for verification, the public should not be complacent and are encouraged to be vigilant at all times;

**WHEREAS**, despite of these rampant unverified news circulating in the internet, the City PNP and other city government's security allies such as the SK3 should still on guard to prevent the happening of the same in our locality and schools which are already open for face to face classes;

**WHEREAS**, parents and school personnel should also be reminded to provide their students necessary instructions on how to prevent from being victim of kidnapping inside and outside the school campus;

**WHEREAS**, police visibility in school campuses and strategic locations and the conduct of programs or activities providing instructions for students in relation thereto could somehow lessen if not suppressed the incident of kidnapping in and out of schools;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, duly seconded by **Hon. Danilo A. Deladia**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the City PNP to intensify police visibility specially in all school campuses and conduct programs and activities to ensure safety of pupils, students and school personel in the City of Sorsogon.
