RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE CITY GOVERNMENT'S APPRECIATION TO ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL TEACHERS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON FOR THEIR DEDICATION AND SERVICE AS THEY CELEBRATE THE 2022 NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH AND WORLD TEACHERS DAY AND THEREBY COMMENDING THEM FOR BEING INNOVATIVE AND RESILIENT DURING THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, by virtue of DepEd Proclamation No. 242, Series of 2011, the celebration of 2022 National Teachers' Month (NTM) formally started on Monday, Sept. 5 and will culminate on Oct. 5, with the theme, "Gurong Pilipino, Dangal ng Sambayanang Pilipino,";

WHEREAS, the month-long celebration aims to honor the greatness and dedication of teachers in helping Filipino youth to reach their dreams, because in times of uncertainty and change such as pandemic, our teachers are there for our students, providing them with love and support, helping them to navigate the changes in their own lives, and empowering them to shape a brighter future for our world;

WHEREAS, the condition of education is best reflected in the conditions of our teachers as they bear all the problems of the education system, hence, for education to recover from the learning crisis, uplifting the conditions of our teachers is core and essential;

WHEREAS, the state gives importance to education in adherence to the 1987 Philippine Constitution, under Article II, Section 17, which states: “The state shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerated social progress and promote total liberation and development”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 12, Series of 2020 which instructs all DepEd governance levels to adapt the Basic Education Learning Community Plan Amidst Covid 19 Pandemic and PD No. 922, Series of 2020 declaring Nationwide Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines, the Schools Division of Sorsogon City deemed it proper to respond to the challenge and adapt to the health crisis in order to bring education to the learners and continue the aim of DepEd to serve children in whatever possible way it can;
