RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE HON. MA. ESTER E. HAMOR, CITY MAYOR, SORSOGON CITY THROUGH THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD TO ALLOCATE FUNDS INTENDED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND LEARNING FACILITIES TO ACCOMMODATE THE INCREASING POPULATION OF PUPILS AND STUDENTS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, the state gives importance to education in adherence to the 1987 Philippine Constitution, under Article II, Section 17, which states: "The state shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to poster patriotism and nationalism, accelerated social progress and promote total liberation and development";

WHEREAS, after more than two years of school closures, millions of public school students are set to return to classrooms this school year after the DepEd ordered schools to shift to five-day in-person classes:

WHEREAS, statistics and data analysis showed that public schools suffer classroom shortage, thus education also suffers in terms of efficiency;

WHEREAS, the effect of having room shortages for schools, some classrooms are divided into two for they have the lack of classrooms that their schools should have been provided, thus, the interaction between teacher and pupils was severely effective due and pupils/students did not get enough individual assistance from their teachers during teaching-learning process;

WHEREAS, the lack of classrooms and learning facilities in every school limits the quality and quantity of interactions between the teachers and students as well as on the quality of teaching and learning, to the detriment of the learning process and system;

WHEREAS, Sec. 99 of RA 7160 provides that the Local School Board shall serve as an advisory committee to the Sanggunian concerned on educational matters such as, but not limited to the necessity for and the uses of local appropriations for educational purposes;

WHEREAS, Sec. 100 of the same code likewise provides that the annual school board budget shall give priority among others to the construction, repair, and maintenance of school buildings and other facilities of public elementary and secondary schools and establishment and maintenance of extension classes where necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Ma. Teresa D. Perdigon**, duly seconded by **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request Hon. Ma. Ester E. Hamor, City Mayor, Sorsogon City through the Local School Board to allocate funds intended for the construction of school buildings and learning facilities to accommodate the increasing population of pupils and students in the City of Sorsogon.


RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished all concerned parties for their information and guidance.
