RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL-EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RESOLUTION NO. 01, SERIES OF 2022 (RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REPROGRAMMING OF THE UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF PROJECTS UNDER THE 2021 20% DEVELOPMENT FUND AMOUNTING TO ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE AND 13/100 (P1,961,845.13))

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2022, Hon. Ma. Ester E. Hamor, City Mayor, Sorsogon City wrote a letter addressed to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod thru Hon. Mark Eric C. Dioneda, City Vice Mayor, Sorsogon City respectfully requesting among others, adoption, approval and enactment of RESOLUTION NO. 01, SERIES OF 2022 OF THE CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (CDC) held last June 7, 2022 entitled "RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REPROGRAMMING OF THE UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF PROJECTS UNDER THE 2021 20% DEVELOPMENT FUND AMOUNTING TO ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE AND 13/100 (P1,961,845.13);

WHEREAS, the identified programs, projects and activities will contribute to the attainment of socio-economic development of the City and more beneficial to the people;

WHEREAS, the projects under the 2021 20% development fund were implemented and as of December 31, 2021, there was a remaining balance of One million nine hundred sixty-one thousand eight hundred forty-five and 13/100 (P1,961,845.13);

WHEREAS, for immediate implementation of priority projects being lined up, there is a need to reprogram the unexpended balances from the various projects already implemented from 2021;

WHEREAS, the projects identified are consistent with the priorities under the Local Development Plan and complements the overall national and global goals and aspirations;

NOW THEREFORE, on incidental motion of **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, duly seconded by the **Hon. Danilo A.
