RESOLUTION ADOPTING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3, SERIES OF 2022 OF THE PRESIDENT ALLOWING VOLUNTARY WEARING OF FACE MASK IN OUTDOOR SETTINGS AND REITERATING THE CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS DURING THE STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RELATIVE TO COVID 19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, Section 6(e) of Republic Act No. 11332, "The Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act," provides that local governments have the authority to conduct and enforce disease surveillance and response systems, epidemic/outbreak and epidemiologic investigations, and rapid containment, quarantine and isolation, disease prevention and control measures;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 14, Series of 2021 required the mandatory wearing of facemask and face shield and observance of Social/Physical Distancing in all public places in the City of Sorsogon and imposed penalties for violations thereof;

WHEREAS, due to relatively decreasing number of Covid 19 cases in the city of Sorsogon City and placing us in the low-risk category, corresponding modifications of health and safety protocols may be allowed;

WHEREAS, based on Section 16 of the Local Government Code, every local government unit has the implied power to do all things necessary, appropriate, or incidental to govern efficiently and effectively, promote general welfare, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Jo Abegail C. Dioneda**, duly seconded by **Hon. Renalene Mae J. Duka**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to adopt Executive Order No. 3, Series of 2022 of the President allowing voluntary wearing of face mask in outdoor settings and reiterating the continued implementation of minimum public health standards during the state of public health emergency relative to Covid 19 pandemic.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.
