RESOLUTION ENJOINING THE CITY VETERINARY OFFICE TO STRENGTHEN THE BORDER CONTROL POINTS OF THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON AMID AFRICAN SWINE FEVER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF STA. MAGDALENA.

**WHEREAS**, African Swine Fever (ASF) is a highly contagious viral disease among hogs and an acute form of disease generally results in high mortality;

**WHEREAS**, African Swine Fever (ASF) is caused by African swine fever virus (ASFV), which can cause substantial morbidity and mortality events in swine wherein the virus can be transmitted via direct and indirect contacts with infected swine, their products, or competent vector species, especially Ornithodoros ticks;

**WHEREAS**, immediate precautionary measures is of the essence specially when African Swine Fever (ASF) had been reported in the Municipality of Sta. Magdalena;

**WHEREAS**, foregoing premise considered and after due deliberation on the matter, the 8<sup>th</sup> City Council deemed it necessary to pass a resolution enjoining the City Veterinary Office to strengthen the border control points of the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon amid African Swine Fever in the Municipality of Sta. Magdalena;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Angelu Magda P. Ravanilla duly seconded by City Councilor Renalene Mae J. Duka, resolve as it is hereby resolved to enjoin the City Veterinary Office to strengthen the border control points of the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Sorsogon amid African Swine Fever in the Municipality of Sta. Magdalena;
