RESOLUTION MOST RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY VETERINARIAN AND THE 64 BARANGAYS OF THE CITY OF SORSOGON TO CONDUCT REGISTRATION OF LIVESTOCK AND THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS UNDER CHAPTER IV, SECTION 9 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 12, SERIES OF 2008 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE SORSOGON CITY ANIMAL WELFARE AND RESPONSIBLE OWNERSHIP, POSSESSION AND LIABILITY ORDINANCE OF 2008

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2008, otherwise known as the Sorsogon City Animal Welfare and Responsible Ownership, Possession and Liability Ordinance of 2008 was approved by the 3rd City Council on April 15, 2008, with end view of imposing sanctions and liabilities to the irresponsible owner/s of domesticated animals in case of death, injuries and destructions to properties;

WHEREAS, Chapter IV, Section 9 of City Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2008 covers the obligations and liabilities of the owners of beast animals, such as carabaos, cattle, horses, goats, pigs, sheep and other similar kind of beasts of burden;

WHEREAS, the same section of the Ordinance required the owners of the beasts of burden to register carabaos and cattle and control their animals within the premises of estate by leashing or providing their animals with appropriate confinement and the necessary supplements;

WHEREAS, under the same provision, leashing of such animals in any public places along the roads, parks, plaza and the likes is strictly prohibited;

WHEREAS, it was observed that there are number of residents in the barangays that are still unaware of these restrictions, making them vulnerable to criminal and civil liabilities for any incidents of destruction, death or road accidents caused by their own irresponsible practices;

WHEREAS, this legislative measure is in relation to the manifestation of Mr. Daniel P. Jazmin, III, Assistant Focal Person of the KALIKASAN Program, one of the 7K Programs of the Provincial Government of Sorsogon during the consultative meeting on September 30, 2022 requiring all the City and or Municipalities of Sorsogon for the enactment of such ordinance to which the City has already an existing similar ordinance which is the City Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2008;

WHEREAS, proper information dissemination of these restrictions and efficient enforcement or implementation of this ordinance could save our constituents from any danger for loss of lives and properties;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Maria Theresa S. Gonzalez**, duly seconded by **Hon. Danilo A. Deladia**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the Office of the City Veterinarian and the 64 Barangays of the City of Sorsogon to conduct registration of livestock and the enforcement of the provisions under Chapter IV, Section 9 of City Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2008 otherwise known as the Sorsogon City Animal Welfare and Responsible Ownership, Possession and Liability Ordinance of 2008.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.
