RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING ATTY. PITERO M. REIG, CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER, PARK SOLUTIONS, INC. TO CONSIDER THE POSSIBLE REDUCTION IN THE GRADUATED RATE OF NOTICE TO PROCEED AMONG TRANSPORT GROUPS UTILIZING THE SORSOGON INTEGRATED TERMINAL EXCHANGE (SITEX).

WHEREAS, series of committee hearing spearheaded by the Committee on Transportation and Public Utilities chaired by the Hon. Danilo A. Deladia concerning the operation of Sorsogon Integrated Terminal Exchange located SM Sorsogon City, Barangay Balogo, East District, Sorsogon City;

WHEREAS, as always mentioned by the Hon. Baldon during these committee hearings, he would prefer to incorporate in his ordinance the terminal rates and terminal rules in regulations so as to protect the interest of Park Solutions, Inc. and transport groups to be occupying Sorsogon Integrated Terminal Exchange (SITEX);

WHEREAS, as an update, the SITEX Terminal Rules and Regulations had been presented before the transport groups with no objection, however, as regards to Terminal Rates, Fees and Charges, the transport groups expressed their appeal to consider the reduction in Graduated Rate of Notice to Proceed;

WHEREAS, as regards to other fees and charges, transport groups agreed as presented with condition that the amount of Quarterly payments be divided into Ninety (90) days;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of the **City Councilor Nestor J. Baldon** duly seconded by **City Councilor Renalene Mae J. Duka**, resolve as it is hereby resolved to pass a resolution respectfully requesting Atty. Pitero M. Reig, Chief Operating Officer, Park Solutions, Inc. to consider the possible reduction in the graduated Rate of Notice to Proceed among transport groups utilizing the Sorsogon Integrated Terminal Exchange (SITEX);

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution be considered as an avenue for conveying the appeal of transport groups to SITEX Management;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished to Atty. Pitero M. Reig, COO, SITEX for his information and guidance
