RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE SIMULTANEOUS MONTHLY BAYANIHAN CLEAN UP DRIVE OF ALL BARANGAYS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON, INTEGRATING THE SAME AS A COMPONENT OF THE “GAYON SORSOGON” OF THE 10-POINT AGENDA OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SORSOGON AND IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE LIABILITY FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the efforts of the barangays to maintain clean streets and sidewalks not enough without the help, cooperation and participation of the residents and dwellers thereof;
WHEREAS, the discipline, support and cooperation of barangay residents are needed to discourage and stop the dumping of garbage outside their residences;

WHEREAS, “Gayon Sorsogon” of the 10 Point Agenda of the city government promotes sustainable tourism and environment-friendly endeavors, thus, cleanliness and sanitation of streets, including its alleys and sidewalks encourage and attract local and foreign business investors and tourists;

WHEREAS, regular conduct of clean up drive could prevent dengue which is a debilitating mosquito borne-disease, carried by its common vector *Aedes Aegypti* mosquito;

WHEREAS, dengue is already an endemic and no longer considered as a seasonal epidemic and the same already a whole year nationwide scenario;

WHEREAS, there is a marching and standing order from the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the provincial government of Sorsogon for a regular conduct of a massive cleanup drive in every barangay to address the problem of Dengue cases in the locality;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2009, which states that it is the policy of the state to adopt a comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program which shall institutionalize public participation in the development and implementation of local integrated, comprehensive, and ecological waste management;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Danilo A. Deladia**, duly seconded by **Hon. Renalene Mae J. Duka**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to enact an ordinance institutionalizing the simultaneous monthly bayanihan clean up drive of all barangays in the city of Sorsogon, integrating the same as a component of the “Gayon Sorsogon” of the 10-point agenda of the City Government of Sorsogon.

City Ordinance No. 009, Series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE SIMULTANEOUS MONTHLY BAYANIHAN CLEAN UP DRIVE OF ALL BARANGAYS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON, INTEGRATING THE SAME AS A COMPONENT OF THE “GAYON SORSOGON” OF THE 10-POINT AGENDA OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF SORSOGON AND IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE LIABILITY FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session that:

SECTION 1 **TITLE**

This ordinance shall be known as the “**BARANGAY SIMULTANEOUS MONTHLY BAYANIHAN CLEAN UP DRIVE ORDINANCE OF 2022**”.

SECTION 2 **SCOPE/COVERAGE**

This ordinance shall cover the conduct of simultaneous monthly clean-up drive of all barangays in the City of Sorsogon to be participated by their respective residents, Civil Society Organizations, barangay officials and appointees.

SECTION 3 **POLICIES AND OBJECTIVES**

It is a declared policy of the city government of Sorsogon to promote and protect the health, safety, peace, convenience and general welfare of its inhabitants. Towards this end, the city government required the support, discipline, cooperation and participation of its residents to maintain the cleanliness and sanitation of their respective property compound or premises, barangay streets and sidewalks.

The objective of this ordinance is to ensure regular cleanliness within the barangays by eradicating unsightly, uncovered and overflowing waste containers in streets, public and open places for the promotion of tourism, to avoid dengue cases and all other similar or related scenarios.

SECTION 4

SIMULTANEOUS MONTHLY CLEAN UP DRIVE IN THE BARANGAYS

The sixty-four (64) barangays of Sorsogon City are hereby enjoined to conduct regular and simultaneous monthly clean up drive in their respective territorial jurisdictions every first (1st) Saturday of every month. The Punong Barangay shall initiate such barangay/community based clean up drive making it as a regular activity to be done every month.

The Punong Barangays shall lead, with the active participation of all Barangay Kagawads and their appointees and Civil Society Organizations, in the implementation of the following:

- a. Dredging/cleaning of clogged canals, esteros, and other waterways;
- b. Pruning/cutting of overgrown/thick bushes, plant foliage/vegetation and tree branches;
- c. Removal of water-collecting receptacles like old tires, tin cans, plastic containers, etc., which cause stagnant water.
- d. Collection of garbage and litters from residential houses. Wastes from every clean up drive shall be collected and dispose in accordance with the provisions under Republic Act No. 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) and City Ordinance No. 007, Series of 2005, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of the City of Sorsogon.

It shall be the responsibility of the owner and/or dweller, lessee or occupant/s of a residential house in the barangay to keep and maintain the cleanliness and sanitation of property compound or premises, setback and the sidewalks and its curb and gutter, fronting, adjacent and surroundings their respective residential house. It shall be the duty of the above-mentioned persons to dispose their garbage and litters in a sanitary manner and kept inside the residence premises until the same is collected by the barangay.

Residents are mandated to practice waste segregation-at-source as defined and prescribed under Republic Act No. 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) and City Ordinance No. 007, Series of 2005, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of the City of Sorsogon".

Empty plastic bottle/container, empty glass bottle/container, white goods, papers, magazines, books, carton packs/boxes and other similar materials shall be properly disposed and the barangays shall have the authority to sell the same to accredited buyer of recyclable wastes. All other non-biodegradable wastes shall be collected by the barangay to be disposed at the Barangay Materials Recovery Facility.

Biodegradable wastes shall be collected by the garbage trucks/collectors of the city government and shall be disposed at the City Materials Recovery Facility for processing.

No collection and disposal of garbage shall be conducted until and unless the same is segregated-at-source with the corresponding receptacles or labels

SECTION 5

COMPLIANCE REPORT

All barangays shall submit monthly compliance report supported with documentations and shall be submitted to the Office of the City Mayor and to the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG-Sorsogon City).

Failure of any barangay and/or its officials to comply with this provision shall constitute dereliction of duty in consonance with the relevant provisions under Chapter IV, Section 60 of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991. However, imposition of penalties shall be in accordance of Section 6 of this ordinance

SECTION 6.

PENAL PROVISIONS.

Hereunder are the gradual penalties imposed upon erring barangay officials who fails to comply with relevant provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. MERIT AND AWARD SYSTEM

The City Government of Sorsogon shall establish a Merit and Award System to barangays who displayed consistency and active participation for the intent and purpose of this ordinance. The City Environment and Natural Resources Office shall upon approval of this ordinance formulate a Merit and Award System subject to approval and perusal of the local chief executive.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

The City Environment and Natural Resources Office shall prepare the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this ordinance within sixty (60) days upon approval of this ordinance.

SECTION 9 REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, resolutions and regulations, or any part(s) thereof which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10 SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provision hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 11 EFFECTIVITY

This ordinance shall take immediately upon its approval by the Sangguniang Panlungsod and after compliance with the law on public dissemination and of publication.
