RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE (IATF) FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES TO RECOMMEND TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN FOR THE LIFTING OF CURFEW HOURS IN THE CITY OF SORSOGON

WHEREAS, Sorsogon City, the capital of Sorsogon province, has its population of 182,237, as determined by the 2020 Census, representing 21.99% of the total population of Sorsogon province;

WHEREAS, being the capital of the province of Sorsogon, the city is in its economic golden era, wherein despite of Pandemic, number of business establishments are continuously coming up within and outside the Central Commercial District, such as malls, restaurants/food outlets, service centers, shopping centers/outlets, product and service franchise outlets and other economic players;

WHEREAS, Sorsogon City is already in a full blast economic recovery, wherein most of the shopping malls, entertainment and recreational centers and other establishments were operating even during night times;

WHEREAS, celebration of Christmas holidays is fast approaching wherein people are excited in their preparations for parties, get together, merry making activities and “Simbang Gabi”, such activities and gatherings they were deprived for the past two years;

WHEREAS, other LGUs have already lifted their curfew hours and suspended its ordinances related thereto;

WHEREAS, Sorsogon City, being categorized under Level 1, hereby humbly request for the lifting of the curfew hours and the suspension of the Provincial Ordinance on curfew to provide public convenience for the celebration of Christmas holidays and to pave way the economic recovery programs of the city of Sorsogon;

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom; as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitant;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon**, duly seconded by **Hon. Renalene Mae J. Duka**, resolved as it is hereby resolve to respectfully request the Provincial Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to recommend to the Office of the Governor and to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for the lifting of curfew hours in the city of Sorsogon.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned for their information and guidance.
