RESOLUTION STRONGLY ENDORSING AND SUPPORTING THE INTENTION OF THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION SORSOGON TO ACQUIRE A MINI PUMPER FIRE TRUCK (PENETRATOR) IN ORDER TO ENSURE THE FULLEST PROTECTION OF THE CONSTITUENTS AGAINST DESTRUCTIVE FIRES.

WHEREAS, both Republic Act No. 6975, the DILG Act of 1990 and congruent with Republic Act 9517, the Fire Code of the Philippines mandate the utmost prevention and suppression of destructive fires with the vigilant and active participation of the community;

WHEREAS, Sorsogon City being a 3rd class component city is divided into three districts and covers within its territorial jurisdiction sixty-four barangays.

WHEREAS, it is admitted being factual that in the recent years there had been unabated increase in the population of Sorsogon City and that in all probability more households will be erected;

WHEREAS, it has been a common practice among those who have less in life and privilege to live in far-flung communities to venture in agriculture and fishing as their source of livelihood;

WHEREAS, this practice would expose them to greater risks in case of destructive fires and in the same token those who are living in areas with narrow streets or passage ways which are hardly passable to heavy vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Hon. Nestor J. Baldon** duly seconded by **Hon. Danilo A. Deladia**, resolved strongly endorsing and supporting the intention of the Bureau of Fire Protection Sorsogon to acquire a mini pumper fire truck (penetrator) in order to ensure the fullest protection of the constituents against destructive fires.
